Patagonia Europe is the regional branch of the global outdoor clothing company **Patagonia**, renowned for its commitment to **environmental sustainability, social justice, and inclusive business practices**. The company designs durable outdoor apparel and gear while prioritizing **fair labor practices, circular economy principles, and activism-driven initiatives**.

Patagonia's mission is clear: "*We're in business to save our home planet.*" Beyond environmentalism, the company embeds **social impact and inclusion** into its core operations, ensuring equity for workers, marginalized communities, and consumers alike.

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Fair Labor Practices & Worker Welfare

Fair Trade Certified™ Apparel: Patagonia was one of the first outdoor brands to adopt Fair Trade certification, ensuring fair wages and safe working conditions for factory workers in its supply chain.

Worker Well-being Programs: The company invests in on-site childcare, healthcare, and education programs for workers in partner factories.

Living Wage Advocacy: Patagonia collaborates with NGOs to promote living wage policies across the garment industry.

Inclusive Design & Accessibility

Adaptive Clothing Line: Patagonia designs outdoor gear for people with disabilities, including adaptive wetsuits and jackets with magnetic zippers for ease of use.

Gender Equity in Design: The company avoids gendered pricing (e.g., "pink tax") and ensures functional, inclusive sizing.

Community-Driven Product Development: Patagonia engages with Indigenous communities (e.g., Inuit collaborators) to co-design culturally respectful outdoor gear.





Social Justice & Activism

1% for the Planet: Patagonia donates 1% of sales to environmental and social justice nonprofits, totaling over \$140 million since 1985.

Grassroots Support: The company funds frontline activists fighting for racial equity, climate justice, and Indigenous rights.

Employee Activism Policy: Patagonia encourages employees to participate in protests and provides paid time off for civic engagement.


Circular Economy & Equity in Consumption

Worn Wear Program: Patagonia repairs, resells, and recycles used gear, making sustainable outdoor apparel accessible to lower-income consumers.

Free Repair Services: The company offers free repair clinics, extending product lifespans and reducing waste.

Transparent Supply Chain: Patagonia publishes its factory list and labor practices, holding itself accountable for equity across production.
